We are pleased to announce an open call for nominations for the 2017 UC Women's Initiative for Professional Development. The Initiative is a UC Systemwide Talent Management program developed at the request of the UC Systemwide Advisory Committee on the Status of Women (SACSW), and delivered by CORO, a non-profit leadership development organization.

The purpose of the program is to provide professional development for mid-career women, both faculty and staff, who demonstrate the potential to advance their careers at UC. The program began as a small pilot in 2016, and is now being expanded.

The curriculum includes participation in a vibrant, professional network of women across the UC system, access to top UC leaders to learn about their leadership approaches and journeys, and strengthening of skills and confidence through hands-on practice with a range of tools and skills.

Nomination Process

Participation is limited to four women from Berkeley, who will join a total Northern UC cohort of 32 participants.

In order to participate in the program, participants must commit to attending all program sessions (four day-anda-half long sessions between February and May 2017), and have approval from their supervisor/department chair to participate. The cost is \$2,500 per participant (plus travel expenses), which will be paid for by the University.

Individuals are encouraged to self-nominate for consideration, or to nominate others. The following two items must be submitted by 5:00 pm, Tuesday, November 1, 2016:

- 1. Online Nomination Form
- 2. <u>Supplemental Questionnaire</u>
