Reference Letters

Applicants can **still send a reference a letter request** even after the recruitment has closed, but only if they've sent one before. Because the application is considered complete as soon as the first request is sent, this does not allow anyone to become complete that wasn't already, but it allows references who lost the email or who never received it to get a new copy and log in to provide their letter.

Reporting

At the Governance Board's request, we have **updated the applicant status names**. "Selected candidate" has been renamed to "Proposed candidate", to reflect that this candidate still needs to be approved by the powers that be before they receive an offer.

Bug Fixes

- Application flags that are marked as hidden from reviewers are now properly hidden from reviewers in the applicant log. They were always hidden on the applicant review screen.
- Attempting to add a custom disposition reason longer than 200 characters (the maximum length) no longer breaks the form; it simply prevents the user from adding more characters.
